Message to Members

In March, we were informed all public and private schools were ordered closed as a result of COVID-19. Soon after, we were instructed to "Stay Home, Stay Safe," and later, it became a global pandemic, no vaccine, and no cure.

As financial institutions, credit unions qualified as essential businesses; we were now part of the front-line.

We distributed anti-bacterial hand sanitizer to teller stations, office desks, and countertops in record time. We passed out latex gloves to our drive-thru tellers, located disposable face masks, sewed together cotton face masks, and circulated them to our staff.

We separated into two groups and rotated those who worked in the credit union and home. Some of us booted up in makeshift offices in our homes, and others greeted each other six feet apart.

As we listened to the news of rising cases and briefings of daily statistics and facts of those infected and how the federal government was rationing out ventilators, masks, and test kits, we were broadcasting emails and posting messages on Facebook and our website of the financial relief options we were offering our members. We publicized skip-a-pays and low-interest emergency loans.

As the days turned in to weeks and then months, it became apparent the best cure was for us to work together; inevitably, we became better together. Together we became confident with new roles and rallied together to help an overwhelmed staff person or department. Together we learned to become patient with staff having to balance work and teaching their children. Together we showed kindness to the member who swallowed their pride to ask for help. I don't know when this pandemic will end or what the new normal will be, I do know we will survive, and we will do it together.
